The essence of the re-invented Stanley & Livingstone is 'Quintessentially Historic'. Inspired by contemporary colonial style, the character will be simple yet edgy. Respecting the roots and rich history of the Hotel, we aim to create spaces that play boldly on natural light, incorporate tenacious quirky design and playful eccentricity.

Unique Selling Points

- Victoria Falls' first Boutique Hotel (with only 16 Luxury Suites, and private spa & gymnasium)
- Spectacular grounds, with landscaped gardens and uninterrupted views of the waterhole
- Peace and tranquility just outside the busy town of Victoria Falls, away from the bustle and noise
- Situated within The Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve, a 6000 acre Big Five reserve, which is part of the greater Zambezi National Park
- 8.5 km/ 5.23 mi from Victoria Falls (10 minutes)
- 12 km/ 7.4 mi from Victoria Falls International Airport (15 minutes)

- 16 luxury Suites with private patios, air-conditioning, shower and bath, satellite television, telephone and mini bar
- All Suites can be configured as twin or double
- Two interleading sets of Suites (7&8 and 9&10), each including one triple Suite
- Gourmet Restaurant with elevated patio overlooking a waterhole. Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner

Best Time to Travel

- An excellent all-year-round destination
- February to May, after the region's rains, are when the Falls are at their most impressive
- June through to August bring warm days and cool evenings. There is little to no rain, and still plenty of water cascading down the Falls
- Although October to November are dry periods (and therefore the Falls are at their lowest), you can expect beautiful panoramic views without the mist
- Unlike the Zambian side, waterflow on the Zimbabwean side is permanent (but ebbs in volume with the seasons)

Weather

- Hot summers from September through to April, and mild winters from May through to August
- Summer runs from October to April, during which time temperatures reach in the vicinity of 30°C. After sunset temperatures drop to approximately 14°C. Dramatic thunderstorms and summer rains can be expected between November and March
- Winter is from May to September/October. The days are mild and largely dry and sunny - around 20°C. Temperature after sunset can get as cold as 5°C

Activities

Activities can be booked through our Travel Desk at an additional cost.

- **Morning Game Drive with breakfast** (Optional Water Safari on private lake)
- **Evening Game Drive with boma dinner** (Optional Water Safari on private lake)
- **Walking Safari**
- **Flying Fox (Cable Slide):** Imagine taking a running jump into thin air over the chasm, soaring horizontally through the air over the turmoil of the Zambezi below. The gorge at this point is 200 meters wide and 120 meters deep. This is a great appetizer before you try the Zip Line and Gorge Swing
- **Gorge Swing:** Imagine swinging in a child's swing in the playground...now imagine a giant swing 95m long and 120m high above water...now imagine a 70m free fall before you begin swinging. Stop imagining and come and try it out! Highlights & General Information: Our highwire is suspended across the gorge at a point where the width is 316m
- **White Water Rafting:** The wildest white water in the world, White Water Rafting on the Zambezi River is an adrenaline rush not to be missed. Victoria Falls is a mile long curtain of water that stretches across the glistening basalt rock, erupts into spray, and then thunders into the canyons below
- **Zipline:** This is the longest Zip Line (Foofie Slide) ride in the world. Imagine the adrenalin rush traveling a speed of 106 km's hurtling 425m across the gorge, while suspended 120m above the breath taking beauty of the Zambezi water below!
- **Bird Watching Safari:** Over 130 species have been seen in one day! Catering for the keen twitcher, our bird watching safari offers tailor-made trips depending on which species are needed to be found. Either by open safari vehicle, by foot or by boat we search for an array of species through a variety of habitats
- **Fishing:** The Zambezi Fishing is famous because of the great freshwater game fish - The Tigerfish. Zambezi Fishing: The mighty Zambezi River has become the number one destination for avid fresh water anglers to "take on" the ferocious tiger fish (Hydrocynus Vittatus). Powerful, swift predators Tigerfish
- **Helicopter Flights over Victoria Falls:** The spectacular helicopter flight over the Victoria Falls is known as the 'Flight of Angels'. David Livingstone famously wrote on seeing the Victoria Falls for the first time in 1855 that "Scenes so lovely must have been gazed upon by angels in their flight". Little did he know that 150 years later he could have exactly that opportunity. The best way to appreciate the true splendour of the Victoria Falls is to view them from the air. Our helicopters have specially designed 'bubble shaped' windows perfect for panoramic viewing and great photographic opportunities from all seats.
12/13 Minute Flight of Angels: After take-off the helicopter turns out towards the magnificent Victoria Falls, our pilot will fly left and right hand circuits over the Victoria Falls in both directions giving you the best viewing, photographic and filming opportunities. A trip up the Zambezi River and back over the Zambezi National Park completes your flight.
25 Minute Zambezi Spectacular: After take-off you will fly out over the Victoria Falls where our pilot will fly left and right hand circuits over the Victoria Falls in both directions. Continuing the flight downstream over the Batoka Gorge, experience the natural beauty of this awe-inspiring dramatic feature, following the mighty Zambezi River, as it carves its way through the steep cliffs. As we head back we fly over the upper Zambezi River & the National Park, home to a wide variety of wildlife species.
- **Chinotimba Township Tour:** Experience the warmth of an African urban settlement. The word Chinotimba describes the roar of the water from the mighty Victoria Falls in the local Nambya language. The Nambya and the Tonga people are the original people of the Victoria Falls area
- **Meet the People Village Tour:** Gain an insight into Zimbabwean rural life. Clients are taken to an authentic rural village approximately 20km from Victoria Falls town where they are given the opportunity to watch local villagers going about their daily tasks
- **The Art Village Tour:** Join us on a multi-faceted and interactive Art Village Tour , involving history, culture, art, and a dinner under the stars. The Art Village Tour consists of a cultural tour and an art workshop: Cultural Tour: This will include an hour long tour in and around the Village
- **Tour of Victoria Falls:** It's a truly awe-inspiring experience - the sight, the sound, the smell; the humbling feeling that here indeed is Nature's Supreme Masterpiece. No photograph can begin to depict the reality...and nothing prepares you for your first sight. **The Victoria Falls - Now in its 150 millionth year - Reaches its Zenith in about May each year.** This tour is conducted in the morning and afternoon. En route, clients may be taken past the 'Big Tree' where they may stop and take photos. Clients will be accompanied through the Rainforest by one of our qualified Guides who will give a brief history of the Falls themselves as well as detailing the flora, fauna, bird & wildlife and other points of interest. Guides are also happy to assist clients with photographs whilst visiting this most spectacular of waterfalls. Raincoats are provided when needed
- **Canopy Tour:** The Victoria Falls Canopy Tour offers amazing views of Zambezi rapids, Victoria Falls Bridge & the spray of the Falls. Observe the riverine forest from a variety of different vantage points - from above, below and within the canopy itself. Experience forest birdlife, which can include the Knysna and Purple crested Turaco (Lourie)

Families

- There are two sets of interleading Suites, each of which has one Suite which is a triple
- A variety of activities are suitable for all ages

Health Related

- **Malaria:** Victoria Falls is located in a malaria area. We suggest you consult with your health practitioner before travelling, to discuss anti-malarial prophylaxis
- **Yellow Fever:** There is no risk of yellow fever in Zimbabwe, and proof of vaccination is only required if you arrive from a country (i.e. Zambia) with risk of yellow fever

Location

10 minutes from the Victoria Falls, situated on the Big Five Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve

Access

- The recommended airport to fly to is Victoria Falls (airport code VFA). A complimentary transfer service is available from the airport to the Hotel
- Private transfers are available at a cost
- You can fly directly to VFA daily from Johannesburg. Airlink has a direct daily flight from Cape Town International (excluding Saturdays)
- As Victoria Falls is only 70km from the Botswana border, travellers can fly to Kasane Airport from the Okavango Delta, or from Maun Airport to VFA
- Rovos Rail Luxury Train; a four-day trip from Pretoria, South Africa to Victoria Falls Town, Zimbabwe

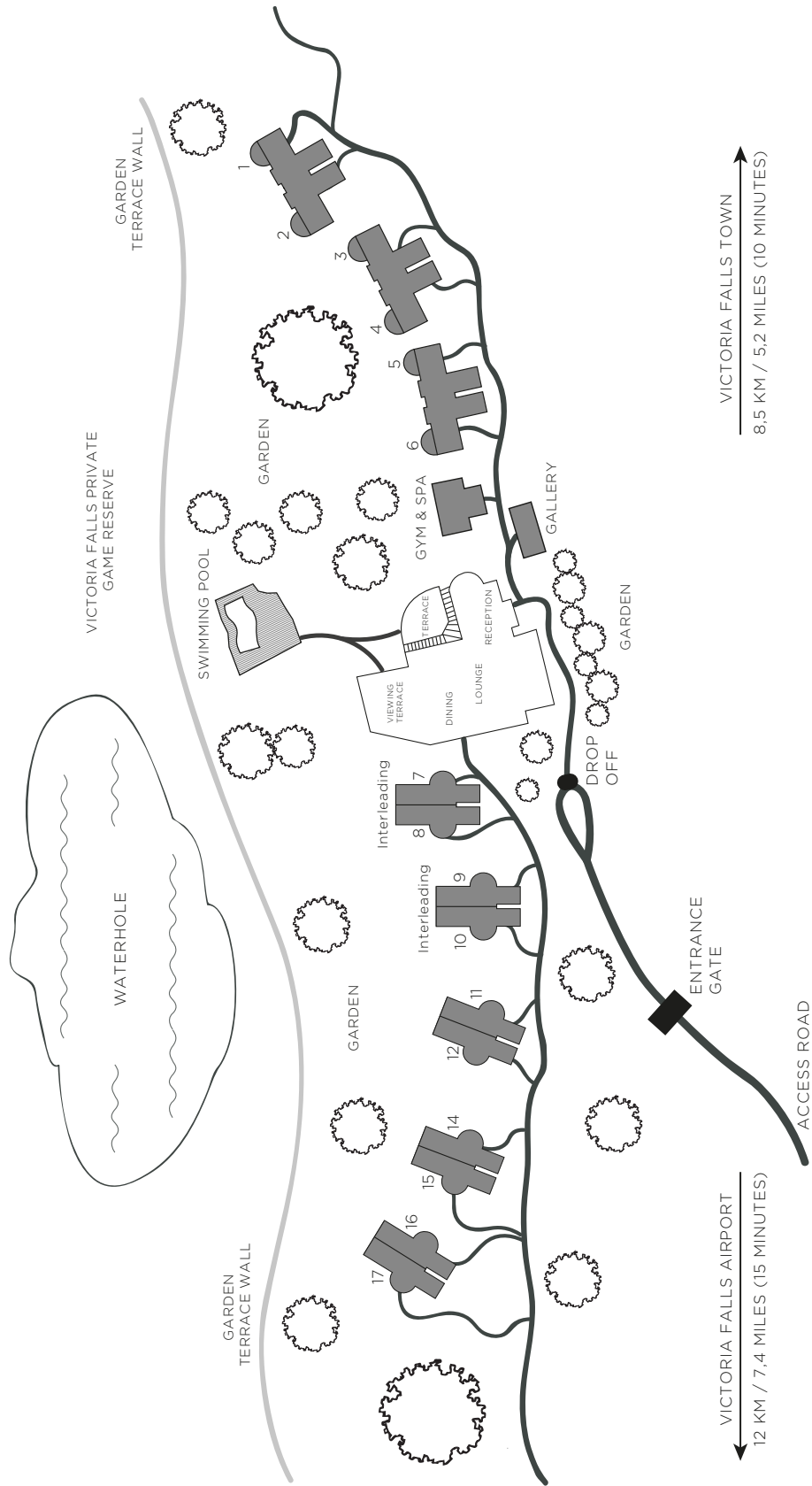

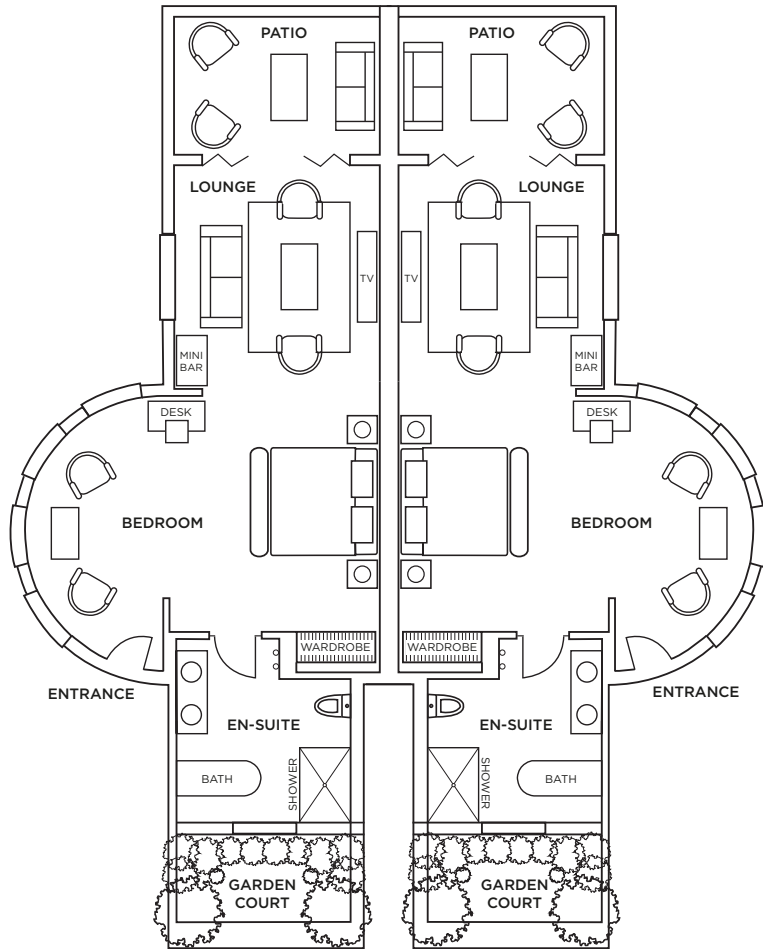

Hotel Layout



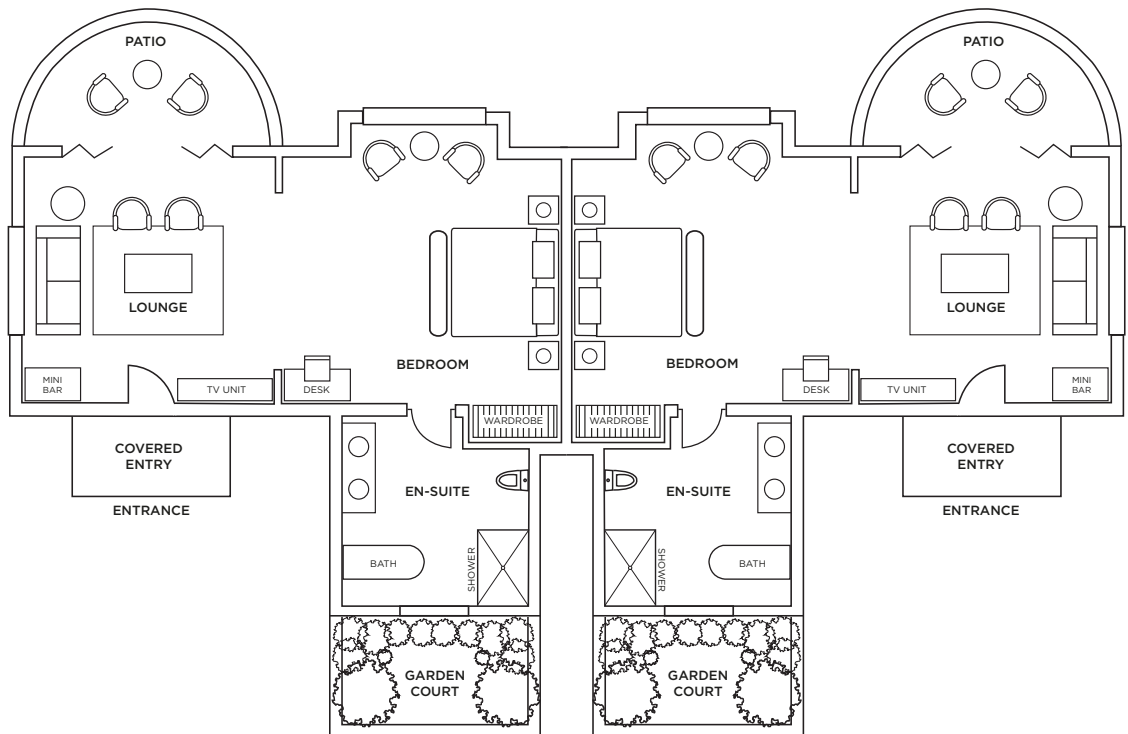
Suite Layout: Type A
